Phoenix Sky Harbor Expands Route Network

Air travelers have more reasons to fly from Phoenix Sky Harbor. American Airlines announced recently that it will offer its first-ever overseas intercontinental flight from Phoenix Sky Harbor International Airport, with service to London Heathrow Airport.

The daily nonstop service between Phoenix and London will begin March 31, 2019 and continue through Oct. 26, 2019. This new route will provide another critical link between Phoenix and Europe for both business and leisure travelers. British Airways will continue its daily nonstop flight to London Heathrow Airport, departing from Phoenix Sky Harbor at 7:45 p.m. British Airways has offered nonstop service between Phoenix and London since 1996.

With American's new service, customers will now have access to 14 flights per week, demonstrating that Phoenix has the demand for more than one daily flight to London. The Fort Worth, Texas-based airline also recently announced plans to add direct service between Sky Harbor and Gerald R. Ford International Airport in Grand Rapids, Michigan, as well as Dane County Regional Airport in Madison, Wisconsin. Both routes run daily but only will be offered seasonally, starting Jan. 6, 2019, and running through April 1.

In addition, low-cost-carrier Frontier Airlines is adding four new destinations from Phoenix Sky Harbor. Beginning in November, Frontier will operate the only non-stop flights from PHX to Fort Myers, Fla., Grand Rapids, Mich., Madison, Wis., and Norfolk, Va.

America's Friendliest Airport® has been focused on increasing international service, welcoming a Condor Airlines flight to Frankfurt, Germany in May and adding new Montreal service earlier this year. Condor very recently increased its Germany route from two days per week to three, which travelers can take advantage of between October and May. In addition, JetBlue announced new service between Phoenix Sky Harbor and Fort Lauderdale, Fla. The service starts on Feb. 14, 2019.
