<u>Blight Buster Volunteer Program (BBVP) – NSD</u> training program that involves illegal sign removal, graffiti removal and removal of blight from our city. (www.phoenix.gov/NSD)

<u>Code of Enforcements</u> – Each area is assigned a Code Enforcement Officer who can speak to groups on city policies and how complaints get processed (loud parties, vehicle impound, alarms).
